Re: Mega Color Match Lite

Dear Ms. Timberlake,

Thank you for submitting the Mega Color Match Lite amusement game, manufactured by LAI Games, to us for review. We have completed our review.

It is my understanding the game plays as follows:

Players select a color to begin play. Then they try to match all the segments on the disc to the same color, one segment at a time. As the player reaches each new segment, it begins changing colors. Players attempt to stop the color on the same color they are trying to match. If the player matches a certain number of colors in the disc they win the minor prize and may continue on to attempt to win the major prize by matching more colors in the disc.

During the review, it was noted there is an option on this game where players make a decision to forfeit the minor prize to move on to attempt to win the major prize. You were advised that this option is not allowed in Washington. WAC 230-12-130 states that operators must not allow winners to forfeit previously won prize(s) in exchange for another play.

The Mega Color Match Lite game meets the definition of an amusement game (RCW 9.46.0201) and is approved for use as a Group 5 Hand/Eye Coordination (WAC 230-13-035) amusement game in Washington State.

Please be advised that any modifications to the Mega Color Match Lite amusement game software or associated equipment must be provided to us for additional testing and review. In addition, amusement games operated in Washington must not have settings that allow the operator to control the outcome of the game (auto percentaging). The approval of this equipment may be rescinded at any time if problems are found by the Commission or changes to the Washington Administrative Code (WAC) impact this approval.
