Dear Mr. Manning,

Thank you for submitting the SpongeBob Squarepants Pineapple amusement game, manufactured by Andamiro Inc., to us for review. In the information submitted, it was noted that the game has been modified for Washington State. Specifically, the bonus plays section displayed on the game has been modified to award bonus tickets instead of bonus plays.

We have completed our review. It is my understanding the game plays as follows:

Players roll a coin down a slide into moving pineapples. If the player is able to time the drop of the coin so it goes through the moving pineapples, they receive a prize. There is a moving light that stops when the coin goes through one of the pineapples. The player receives the prize displayed next to where the light stops. The prizes may be tokens or Spongebob Squarepants character cards that are dropped onto the playfield and may be pushed off the playfield. Tickets may also be awarded to the player. If the player collects all character cards they win the bonus displayed on the game.

The SpongeBob Squarepants Pineapple game meets the definition of an amusement game (RCW 9.46.0201) and is approved for use as a Group 8 Penny Fall (WAC 230-13-050) amusement game in Washington State.

Please be advised that any modifications to the SpongeBob Squarepants Pineapple amusement game software or associated equipment must be provided to us for additional testing and review. In addition, amusement games operated in Washington must not have settings that allow the operator to control the outcome of the game (auto percentaging). The approval of this equipment may be rescinded at any time if problems are found by the Commission or changes to the Washington Administrative Code (WAC) impact this approval.
