Thank you for requesting approval of ViPS v1.2.0. We have completed our review.

The ViPS v1.2.0 is approved for use in Washington State with the following requirements:

- All unused ports in the back of the Aquarius controller be sealed to prevent unauthorized access. This could be accomplished by disabling the ports programmatically or regulator tape can be used to seal the ports with initials placed over the tape.
- All open ports be sealed or have appropriate IC's in place to prevent unauthorized access to the ViPS PC slider board.
