**RE: Galaxy Gaming Single Deck Dealing Shoe
Amended Approval of December 20, 2010 Letter**

Dear Mr. Saucier:

We received your request for an additional review of the Single Deck Dealing Shoe which included a manual and video demonstrating the procedures for using it as a hand held shoe. You requested we remove the requirement for the Single Deck Dealing Shoe to be used only while flat on the gaming table as noted in the December 20, 2010 approval letter (attached).

We have completed our review of the manual and video. Based on our review of this information, we are amending our previous approval. Specifically, we are removing the requirement that card room licensees and Tribal casinos only use the Single Deck Dealing Shoe when it is flat on the gaming table. The shoe may be used as a hand held shoe as described in the manual provided. The procedures for dealing cards from the shoe must be provided to all card room licensees and Tribal casinos that plan to use the Single Deck Dealing Shoe.

Please be advised that all other requirement noted in the December 20, 2010, approval letter must be followed. In addition, any modifications made to the Single Deck Dealing Shoe must be submitted to us for additional testing and review. We reserve the right to investigate and reevaluate this equipment if we determine that such a review is required to ensure compliance.

RE: Galaxy Gaming Single Deck Dealing Shoe

Dear Mr. Saucier,

Thank you for requesting approval of the Single Deck Dealing Shoe. We have completed our review.

The Single Deck Dealing Shoe is approved for use in Washington State with the following requirements:

- House-Banked (HB) licensees and Tribal Casinos using the Single Deck Dealing Shoe must ensure it is only used while flat on the gaming table, never hand held.
- The cards must be shuffled as specified in the HB licensee or Tribal Casino internal controls before being placed into the Single Deck Dealing Shoe.
- HB licensees must ensure the shoe remains in camera coverage at all times.
- Dealers should be trained on proper use of the shoe and should be on the lookout for occasions where multiple cards are issued from the Shoe.
- Rules and procedures designed to prevent cheating on handheld games should be applied to games using the Single Deck Shoe. Additional procedures may be required given the unique nature of the equipment.


