Thank you for requesting approval of the MD2-CR Shuffler firmware upgrade. We have completed our review.

The Multi-Deck Shuffler MD2 v 2.85.013 and the CardRec v 1.4.003 are approved for use in Washington State. We are approving the Multi-Deck Shuffler MD2 v 2.85.013 and the CardRec v 1.4.003 with the following requirements:

- The Workstation Personal Computer feature was not included as part of this submission for our review or approval. Therefore, this feature must be disabled by you prior to shipment to Washington.
- As of the date of this letter, the approved game rules for Super Pan 9 allow for up to eight decks of cards. Operators cannot use 12 decks until and unless game rules have been approved by us to allow the use of 12 decks.
