On April 24, 2006, a meeting was held in the Tacoma office of the Washington State Gambling Commission to review the Diamond/AllTrack 2 Integrated Version 6/17.018/3.11.026 software. Special Agents Sonja Dolson and Bill McGregor met with GameTech representative Jeremy Schwenk to conduct the review.

A sample bingo session was conducted and the applicable receipts/reports were reviewed for compliance with Washington State requirements. There was one exception noted on the reports reviewed. The pay out level for each card was not listed on the player receipt. Mr. Schwenk indicated he would work on having this information added to the player receipts. No other exceptions were noted in this review. Thus, the Diamond/AllTrack 2 software version 7/17.018/3.11.026 complies with the Washington State requirements.

Our review is limited to the receipting requirements and does not review all of the reports produced by your software. Therefore, if some of the reports do not have all of the required information, then a bingo operator may need to take additional steps in order to maintain compliance. You can review Washington State's bingo record keeping requirements via our website, www.wsgc.wa.gov.

The approval of this software may be rescinded at any time if problems are found by the Commission or Washington Administrative Code (WAC) changes impact this approval.
