Dear Mr. Smith:

Thank you for requesting approval of the 50/50 Central/Build 4576. We have completed our review.

The 50/50 Central/Build 4576 is approved for use in Washington State with the following requirements and restrictions:

- All physical connections that go outside of the 50/50 Central Build network must be disconnected to ensure that internet capability is not available.
- All wireless networking equipment must be configured to the following standards:
  - Change default manufacturer information including user name, password and SSID
  - Login passwords must be strong to include a combination of letters, numbers, and symbols at least ten characters long
  - WPA2 or better encryption enabled with AES and a strong passphrase or key
  - MAC address filtering enabled for all clients
  - DHCP functions disabled
- Access to the database must be password protected to prevent unauthorized access.



- Licensees may not operate discount schemes without a rule change. (See Washington Administrative Code 230-11-025 Bundling and Selling tickets at a discount.) The current software gives an error message when the operator attempts to set a discount scheme.
- 50/50 Central may not charge a fee based on a percentage of the raffle receipts. As stated in your Software License agreement, the operator fee will be a fixed amount per event.
- You must notify Washington operators of 50/50 Central/Build 4576 that they must:
  - Make sure all tickets are printed before the drawing and follow all WAC rules relating to the operation and recordkeeping of raffles.
  - Provide each participant who purchases a raffle ticket a copy of the raffle rules, as stated in your Software License Agreement.
  - Hold raffles in which the winner is required to be present to win since not all the required information prints on the tickets, as stated in your Software License Agreement.
- Until you obtain a gambling license, you are not authorized to sell or lease your equipment in this state.

We are approving your equipment at this time but will work to create rules, Washington Administrative Code, to specifically address the parameters of how electronic accounting software for raffles is authorized to be used. When we begin this process, we will invite your input in the rulemaking process.


