
On June 28, 2007, a review of the new electronic bingo dauber, the Tracker, version 1.01.009 was conducted at the Tacoma office of the Washington State Gambling Commission. Tracker version 1.01.009 replaced the previous version 1.01.007 which was submitted for review on March 8, 2007. As part of this review, a sample bingo session was conducted and the applicable receipts/reports were reviewed for compliance. Our review concluded that the Tracker electronic bingo dauber meets Washington requirements and is suitable for installation in Washington.

The Diamond/AllTrack2 software version 6./17.32/3.12.008 was also reviewed at this meeting. During the meeting the "up-sell" feature was discussed. Your representative, Jeremy Schwenk, stated this feature is not currently being used in Washington but could be in the future. If GameTech decides to use this feature an additional review will need to be conducted to ensure the "up-sell" feature is in compliance with applicable rules and laws. Based on our review, the Diamond/AllTrack2 Version 6.17.32/3.12.008 continues to meet Washington State requirements for reporting the electronic dauber activity and is suitable for installation in Washington.

Please be advised that our review is limited to the receipting requirements and does not review all of the reports produced by your software. Bingo operators may need to take additional steps in order to maintain compliance. You can review Washington State's bingo record keeping requirements via our website, [www.wsgc.wa.gov](http://www.wsgc.wa.gov).

The approval of the "Tracker" electronic dauber and the Diamond/AllTrack2 software may be rescinded at any time if problems are found by the Commission or Washington Administrative Code (WAC) changes impact this approval.
