**RE: Galaxy Gaming Bonus Jackpot System Andromeda Series Stage 3d

Dear Mr. Saucier,

Thank you for requesting approval of the Bonus Jackpot System – Andromeda Series – Stage 3d. We have completed our review.

The Bonus Jackpot System-Andromeda Series – Stage 3d is approved for use in Washington State operated only as described in the documentation you provided us in the Game Endorsement Form for New or Upgraded Equipment. In addition, the Table Vision Display is approved for use independently without the other components of the Bonus Jackpot System. The approval is contingent on the following requirements:

- Only licensees or Tribal casinos operating the system shall have access to the system to make changes to the TableVision display (posting and/or choosing paytables or posting the current jackpot amount).
- Auto complete for user name and passwords must be disabled on all web browsers used to access the Andromeda 3d Bonus Jackpot System. For example, Internet Explorer auto complete can be disabled in Windows registry settings. As with wireless functionality, non-Administrator user accounts must not have the capability to modify auto-complete settings.
- Locally disable the Remote Desktop and Wireless services installed on the Pit/Site Controller and/or any laptop or computer connected to the system.
- After installation of the system, HB licensees and Tribal Casinos must ensure that wireless services are disabled on any laptop or computer connected to the system.



- Notification to the Washington State Gambling Commission must be made prior to the first installation in Washington and each installation thereafter so arrangements may be made for Agent inspection/review. Please provide a list to include specific locations, dates and times this system will be installed at least 10 business days prior to installation. Send the list to Sonja Dolson at sonja.dolson@wsgc.wa.gov.

Additional Requirements for HB licensees:

- Ensure HB licensees operating the Andromeda Stage 3d ensure only 9 player positions are allowed per table.
- Ensure HB licensees are not allowing more than four separate games within a single hand.

Requirements for Progressive Jackpot Games:

- Verify HB licensees are aware of the requirements for progressive jackpot games if they use the Andromeda Stage 3d Bonus Jackpot System to operate a progressive jackpot.
- HB licensees who use the system to operate Progressive Jackpot Games must ensure they maintain records that account for all funds collected for progressive jackpot games.
- HB licensees who use the system to operate Progressive Jackpot Games must require a specific wagering limit on the progressive wager (for example all wagers must be \$1) to ensure all funds are accounted for.
- If operating a progressive jackpot game HB licensees must ensure the chips are placed on the center of the sensor to ensure all wagers are accurately recorded.
- If the Table Vision component of this system is used without the rest of the system, the manual process for updating jackpot amounts should be detailed in the licensee's internal controls.

Tribal Casino Implementation:

- For Tribal Casinos, ensure internal controls are revised to include new equipment and procedures, and approved by Tribal Gaming Agency and concurred with by Washington State Gambling Commission.
