On July 31, 2008, a meeting was held in the Tacoma office of the Washington State Gambling Commission to review the Lucky Dog 7 electronic bingo dauber. Special Agent Sonja Dolson met with Bettina representative Denny O'Neil to conduct the review.

A sample bingo session was conducted and the applicable receipts/reports were reviewed for compliance with our rules. No exceptions were noted. The Lucky Dog 7 electronic bingo card dauber complies with Washington State requirements.

Our review is limited to the receipting requirements and does not review all of the reports produced by your software. Therefore, if some of the reports do not have all of the required information; a bingo operator may need to take additional steps in order to maintain compliance.
