Dear: Mr. Coronel:

You requested Commission review of FortuNet's Bingo Star 3000 System (Version 10.0.5) to determine compliance with Washington regulations.

On July 9, 2009, Special Agents Karen Rea and Sonja Dolson met with you and DeWayne Wooten for a demonstration of the equipment. A sample bingo session was conducted and the applicable receipts/reports were reviewed for compliance. No exceptions were noted. The Bingo Star 3000 (Version 10.0.5) electronic bingo card dauber complies with Washington State requirements.

Our review is limited to the receipting requirements for electronic bingo daubers. We do not review all of the reports produced by your software. If some of the reports do not have all of the required information; a bingo operator may need to take additional steps in order to maintain compliance. You can review Washington State's bingo record keeping requirements via our website, www.wsgc.wa.gov.

In addition, the manual provided for review noted all of the different features available on the Bingo Star System. Staff discussed Washington regulations with you and noted some of these features are not allowed in Washington. You advised staff you are aware of Washington rules and laws and those features have been disabled on the WA version 10.0.5.

The approval of this equipment may be rescinded at any time if problems are found by the Commission or Washington Administrative Code (WAC) changes impact this
