**RE: Elite e-FX Display, Advanced Reader Head and Saturn Roulette Wheel- Submission #2073**

Dear Ms. Sholer,

Thank you for requesting approval of the Elite e-FX Display (Elite Display), Advanced Reader Head (ARH-2), and Saturn Roulette Wheel (Saturn Wheel). We have completed our review.

The Elite Display is approved for use with the ARH-2 and the Elite Display is also approved for use with the Saturn Wheel in Washington State Tribal casinos. These approvals are contingent on the following:

Manufacturer Requirements:

- Provide information to the Tribal casino on the minimum number of ball rotations needed to display a winning number result on the Elite Display.
- The Elite Display cabinet should remain locked to secure network, video, USB, and serial ports.
- Notification to the Washington State Gambling Commission (WSGC) must be made prior to the first installation in Washington and each installation thereafter so arrangements may be made for either a WSGC Agent or a Tribal Gaming Agency (TGA) Agent inspection/review. Signatures of the Elite Display and Saturn Wheel must be checked by TGA or WSGC staff prior to being put into play. Please provide a list to include specific locations, dates and times this system will be installed at least 10 business days prior to installation. Send the list to Cathy Harvey at the following email address [Cathy.Harvey@wsgc.wa.gov](mailto:Cathy.Harvey@wsgc.wa.gov). Send a notice of the installation to the appropriate TGA for the casino location.



Tribal Casino Operators:

- Tribal casino dealers should ensure ball spins meet the standards for rotations/spins configurations as set by the manufacturer for accurate display and recording of game outcome/ball drops.
- Tribal casino should include in their internal controls a procedure if the ball spin does not meet the configuration setting and does not display the number on the Elite Display.
- The TGA must verify the signatures of the Elite Display and Saturn Wheel are the approved version prior to being put into play.

We did not test the Elite Display with Gaming Floor Live media system.


The electronic signatures for the Elite Display and Saturn Wheel must be checked prior to installation and are listed below:

Any modifications made to the Elite Display, ARH-2, and Saturn Wheel must be submitted to us for additional testing and review. We have approved the use of the Elite Display with the ARH-2 and the use of the Elite Display with the Saturn Wheel to read and display the outcome of the gambling activity. We reserve the right to investigate and reevaluate this equipment if we determine that such a review is necessary to ensure compliance with applicable rules or laws in Washington.
