RE: Game Manager v6.6 Build 520

Dear Ms. Zarach,

Thank you for requesting approval of the Game Manager v6.6 Build 520 upgrade. We have completed our review.

The Game Manager v6.6 Build 520, that works in conjunction with the Aquarius Controller v6.5.6, approved on October 17, 2006, is approved for use in Washington State to be operated only as described in the documentation you provided us on approximately March 24, 2011. We are approving the Game Manager v6.6 Build 520 with the following requirements:

- All unused ports on the Game Manager computer must be sealed to prevent unauthorized access.
- The deployed Game Manager computer operating system should be locked down and configured similar to the one submitted for review.
- Due to the limitations on manufacturer functions in the WAC and RCW, the manufacturer must not take part in the gambling activity. The manufacturer can only make changes to the jackpot or paytables as directed by the house-banked card room operator.
- You must ensure you have documentation in your game rules regarding the procedures for accruing progressive jackpot funds.



- Prior to installation in Washington, you must update game rules for games that will use Game Manager v6.6 Build 520.

Requirements for Progressive Jackpot Games:

- House-banked licensees who use the system to operate progressive jackpot games must ensure they maintain records that account for all funds collected for progressive jackpot games.
- House-banked licensees who use the system to operate progressive jackpot games must require a specific wagering limit on the progressive wager (for example all wagers must be \$1) to ensure all funds are accounted for.
- House-banked licensees must ensure the chips are placed on the center of the sensor to ensure all wagers are accurately recorded.

Tribal Casino Implementation:

- For Tribal Casinos, ensure internal controls are revised to include new equipment and procedures, and approved by Tribal Gaming Agency and concurred by us.

We anticipate amending our internal control template for house-banked card room operators to require game equipment servers to be under surveillance to ensure the integrity of the games.
