We have reviewed the changes made to Big Slick Blackjack. Based on our review of the documentation we received from Faulkner Enterprises, the Washington State Gambling Commission will approve the game under the conditions listed below:

- The game shall be played and operated under the terms and conditions set forth under the "Big Slick Blackjack Rules of Play" you provided on October 21, 2014 and are enclosed.

Commercial Card Rooms

- Commercial card room operators seeking to operate this game must first submit their internal controls and receive approval from the Commission prior to implementing.
- Manufacturers and distributors of graphic layouts and/or any other equipment associated with the game must be licensed by the state prior to the sale of the equipment.

Tribal Casinos

- Each Tribal Gaming Operation must request and obtain approval from their respective Tribal Gaming Agencies (TGA).
- Before TGA allows your game to operate, they will seek concurrence from our agency as well.
- In addition to your approved rules, the Tribal submission to us must include all supplemental information required by Tribal-State Compact Appendix A, Section 18.

- Manufacturers and distributors of graphic layouts and/or any other equipment associated with the game must be certified by the state and licensed by the Tribe prior to the sale of the equipment.

Big Slick Blackjack Rules

Big Slick Blackjack is a bonus bet to be played with regular blackjack.

Big Slick Blackjack is standard blackjack with an optional bonus wager. All rules pertaining to blackjack as posted on the WSGC website will remain the same and are not altered in this game except as noted in these rules of play.

The house can use 1, 2, or 6 decks of standard playing cards.

The player has an optional bonus wager that their first two cards will make a winning two-card poker hand. Winning hands would be; straights, pairs, straight flushes, and Ace – King (Big Slick) suited.

The card room may also offer the Bonus pay scale where if the player's first two cards are Ace and King suited and the Dealer's first two cards are Ace and King Suited, the Big Slick bonus bet pays 1000 to 1.

All other house blackjack rules apply.

Action Match Bonus Bet

If players wish to act on their hand by taking a hit card from the dealer, they may also make a Action Match Bonus Bet. The player places a wager in the designated “Action Match” betting spot. If the hit card is the same suit as the dealer’s up card but a different rank the wager is a Push and is given back to the player. If the hit card is the same rank as the dealer’s up card, or the same suit and rank as the dealer’s up card, the player wins and is paid according to the posted payout schedule. Otherwise, the house wins and dealer takes the bet.
