RE: FLOP POKER

Dear Mr. Schlumbrecht:

Thank you for requesting approval to market the card game "Flop Poker" to Washington State commercial card rooms and Tribal casinos. Based on our review of the documentation we received from National Table Games, Inc., the Washington State Gambling Commission will approve the game under the conditions listed below:

Commercial Card Rooms

- The game shall be played and operated under the terms and conditions set forth under the "Flop Poker – Rules of Play" you provided.
- Commercial card room operators seeking to operate this game must first submit their internal controls and receive approval from the Commission prior to implementing.
- Manufacturers and distributors of graphic layouts and/or any other equipment associated with the game must be licensed by the state prior to the sale of the equipment.

Tribal Casinos

- The game shall be played and operated under the terms and conditions set forth under the "Flop Poker – Rules of Play" you provided.
- Each Tribal Gaming Operation must request and obtain approval from their respective Tribal Gaming Agencies (TGA).
- Before TGA allows your game to operate, they will seek concurrence from our agency as well.




- In addition to your approved rules, the Tribal submission to us must include all supplemental information required by Tribal-State Compact Appendix A, Section 18.
- Manufacturers and distributors of graphic layouts and/or any other equipment associated with the game must be certified by the state and licensed by the Tribe prior to the sale of the equipment.

Please be advised that until you receive your gambling license, this game cannot be distributed in Washington. If you have any licensing questions, please contact Collene Engle at (360) 486-3539.

Furthermore, any modifications to this game may affect this approval. Contact the Commission should you contemplate modifications. If you have any questions on commercial implementation, please contact Keith Wittmers at (253) 671-6289. Flop Poker Bonus Dealing Procedures

1. Players must make an Ante and Pot bet to start the game. Both bets are required to play the game. Players will also have the option to place a Bonus wager at the start of the game to play for a 3-Card Bonus pay table.
2. The Dealer will collect all pot bets and form a poker “pot” in the center of the table.
3. The Dealer will deliver 3 cards to each Player and a 3-card community “Flop” in the center of the table. All cards are dealt face down. Players will use the initial 3 cards dealt to them to play for the 3-Card Bonus pay table.
4. Players will then evaluate their 3-card hand and decide to make the Flop bet (Equal to the ante bet) or surrender the ante bet and only continue playing for the 3-Card bonus and for the Pot against other Players in the game.
5. The Dealer will then reveal the 3-card community flop. The Dealer will then reveal all player cards settling all casino wagers as each Player hand is exposed. The Dealer will settle all house wagers in this order; 3-Card Bonus bet, Ante bet and Flop bet.
6. Once all House wagers are settled, the Dealer will find the highest ranking 5-card poker hand and pay that player the pot money.
7. The Dealer then collects all players’ and community cards and the next round of play will begin.

3 Important Rules


- * **The Ante bet and Flop bet must be equal amount.**
- * **The ante bet wins even money on all payouts. The Flop bet wins from the house pay table odds.**
- * **The player must use all 3 Player cards dealt to them to form a 5-card poker hand and each player can play only 2 cards from the community flop.**

Card room operators must not allow wagering limits to exceed the authorized limits set out in WAC 230-15-040 and WAC 230-15-140.
