Dear Ms. Kimball,

Thank you for requesting approval to market the card game "One Up!" to Washington State commercial card rooms and Tribal casinos. Based on our review of the documentation we received from Shuffle Master Inc., the Washington State Gambling Commission will approve the game under the conditions listed below:

Commercial Card Rooms

- The game shall be played and operated under the terms and conditions set forth under the "One Up! – Rules of Play" you provided, which are enclosed.
- Commercial card room operators seeking to operate this game must first submit their internal controls and receive approval from the Commission prior to implementing.
- Manufacturers and distributors of graphic layouts and/or any other equipment associated with the game must be licensed by the state prior to the sale of the equipment.

Tribal Casinos

- The game shall be played and operated under the terms and conditions set forth under the "One Up! – Rules of Play" you provided.
- Each Tribal Gaming Operation must request and obtain approval from their respective Tribal Gaming Agencies (TGA).
- Before TGA allows your game to operate, they will seek concurrence from our agency as well.


- In addition to your approved rules, the Tribal submission to us must include all supplemental information required by Tribal-State Compact Appendix A, Section 18.
- Manufacturers and distributors of graphic layouts and/or any other equipment associated with the game must be certified by the state and licensed by the Tribe prior to the sale of the equipment.

Please be advised that the Financial Investigations Unit is currently reviewing your game application for any new substantial interest holders, as defined by WAC 230-03-045, related to this game and may be contacting you.

Furthermore, any modifications to this game may affect this approval. Contact the Commission should you contemplate modifications. One Up! is a standard house-banked Mini-Baccarat game with an optional bonus wager. All rules pertaining to Mini-Baccarat as posted on the WSGC's website remain the same and are not altered in this game.

Training Manual

Introduction

OneUp! is an optional bonus wager for mini-baccarat. Players have two ways to win:

1. If their selected hand for the OneUp! wager wins by a total of 1; or
2. If their selected hand for the OneUp! wager wins with a final total of 1 to 0.

Dealing Procedures

1. Players must make their OneUp! Wager(s) before the dealer reveals any cards.
 - a. Players can bet on either the Player OneUp!, the Banker OneUp!, or both.
 - b. It is left to the casino's discretion as to whether or not the player may make either or both OneUp! wagers without playing the base game of Mini-Baccarat.
2. The dealer will then deal the traditional Mini-Baccarat hand according to house procedures.

3. When the hand is over, the dealer will reconcile the traditional Mini-Baccarat wagers according to house procedures as well as any winning OneUp! wagers.
4. The payable choices for the Player OneUp! and Banker OneUp! bets are as follows:

Hand	Paytable 1	Paytable 2	Paytable 3
Win 1-0	40-to-1	30-to-1	25-to-1
Other Win by 1	8-to-1	9-to-1	9-to-1
all others	lose	lose	lose

Operators cannot allow wagering limits to exceed the authorized limits set out in WAC 230-15-040 and WAC 230-15-140.
