**ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On August 19, 2009, the Director of the Washington State Gambling Commission issued Administrative Charges against Shannon Charles, of Toppenish, for the suspension or revocation of his Class III certification to conduct gambling activities. The charges were issued due to the certified employee's alleged failure to pay court ordered fines and fees.

Following the issuance of the Administrative Charges, Commission staff further reviewed this case and determined that the Administrative Charges against Shannon Charles, of Toppenish, should be dismissed without prejudice.

ORDER


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Commission's Notice of Administrative Charges be dismissed.
