**NOTICE OF ADMINISTRATIVE  
CHARGES AND OPPORTUNITY  
FOR AN ADJUDICATIVE  
PROCEEDING**

I.

The Washington State Gambling Commission issued Sidney's Restaurant and Sports Bar (Sidney's), organization number 00-10332, the following licenses:  
Number 67-00047, authorizing Class "6" House-Banked Card Room activity;  
Number 05-05170, authorizing Class "A" Punchboard/Pull-Tab activity; and  
Number 53-02096, authorizing Class "A" Amusement Game activity.

The licenses expire on June 30, 2011, and were issued subject to the licensee's compliance with state gambling laws and regulations.

II.

Rick Day, Director, of the Washington State Gambling Commission, charges the licensee with the following violations of the Washington State Gambling Act, 9.46 RCW, and WAC Title 230:

The licensee's financial statements were due on April 30, 2010. The licensee requested and was granted a 60-day extension of the deadline. Therefore, the licensee's financial statements were due on June 30, 2010. As of July 29, 2010, the licensee failed to submit its financial statements in violation of WAC 230-15-740.

Therefore, grounds exist to suspend or revoke Sidney's licenses under RCW 9.46.075(1) and WAC 230-03-085(1).

**RCW 9.46.075(1) Denying, suspending, or revoking an application, license**

The Commission may suspend or revoke any license issued by it, for any reason or reasons, it deems to be in the public interest. These reasons shall include, but not be limited to, cases wherein the licensee, or any person with any interest therein has violated, failed or refused to comply with the provisions, requirements, conditions, limitations or duties imposed by chapter 9.46 RCW and any amendments thereto, or any rules adopted by the Commission pursuant thereto, or when a violation of any provision of chapter 9.46 RCW, or any Commission rule, has occurred upon any premises occupied or operated by any such person or over which he or she has substantial control.

**WAC 230-03-085 (1) Denying, suspending, or revoking an application, license**

We may suspend, or revoke any license when the licensee or anyone holding a substantial interest in the applicant's or licensee's business or organization commits any act that constitutes grounds for suspending or revoking licenses under RCW 9.46.075.

**WAC 230-15-740 Preparing financial statements**

(The following subsections apply.)

**Filing with the commission.**

(2) House-banked card game licensees must submit financial statements covering all financial activities of the licensees' business premises for each business year within one hundred twenty days following the end of their business year.

(3) We may authorize a sixty-day extension if a licensee submits a written request explaining the need for the extension.

III.

Jurisdiction of this proceeding is based on 9.46 RCW, Gambling, chapter 34.05 RCW, the Administrative Procedure Act, and WAC Title 230.


The licensee will have the opportunity to have a hearing on the alleged violations. **In order to have a hearing or discuss settlement options**, the enclosed request for hearing must be completed and returned to the Gambling Commission **within 23 days** from the date of the mailing of this notice.

Based on RCW 34.05.440, failure to return a request for hearing will result in the entry of a default order REVOKING your licenses.


