**SETTLEMENT ORDER**

This Settlement Order is entered into between the Washington State Gambling Commission and AAA Bowl Unlimited, Inc., d/b/a Skyway Park Bowl. The Gambling Commission is represented by H. Bruce Marvin, Assistant Attorney General, and Melinda Froud, Lead Staff Attorney. The licensee is represented by Max Cook, bankruptcy court-appointed Receiver.

I.

The Washington State Gambling Commission issued AAA Bowl Unlimited, Inc., d/b/a Skyway Park Bowl, organization number 00-06373, the following licenses:

- Number 67-00014, authorizing Class "14" House-Banked Card Room activity;
- Number 53-00645, authorizing Class "A" Amusement Game activity; and
- Number 05-02696, authorizing Class "E" Punchboard/Pull-Tab activity.

License Number 67-00014, authorizing Class "14" House-Banked Card Room activity expired on December 31, 2010. The following licenses were renewed and expire on December 31, 2011:  
Number 53-00645, authorizing Class "A" Amusement Game activity; and  
Number 05-02696, authorizing Class "A" Punchboard/Pull-Tab activity.

All licenses were issued subject to the licensee's compliance with state gambling laws and regulations.

II.

The Director issued a Notice of Administrative Charges and Opportunity for an Adjudicative Proceeding to the licensee on October 1, 2010. On October 14, 2010, Commission staff received the licensee's Request for Hearing.

III.

The licensee, under former owner Dave Pardey, failed to keep legible, accurate, and complete records of all transactions relating to the revenues, costs, and expenses of the gambling operation. As a result, the licensee was not able to ensure consistency, comparability, and effective disclosure of financial information for 2009, in violation of WAC 230-15-730.

Grounds exist to suspend AAA Bowl Unlimited, Inc., d/b/a Skyway Park Bowl's licenses under RCW 9.46.075(1) and WAC 230-03-085(1).

**RCW 9.46.075 Denying, suspending, or revoking an application, license**

The Commission may deny an application, or suspend or revoke any license or permit issued by it, for any reason or reasons, it deems to be in the public interest. These reasons shall include, but not be limited to, cases wherein the applicant or licensee, or any person with any interest therein: (The following subsection applies.)

(1) Has violated, failed or refused to comply with the provisions, requirements, conditions, limitations or duties imposed by chapter 9.46 RCW and any amendments thereto, or any rules adopted by the Commission pursuant thereto, or when a violation of any provision of chapter 9.46 RCW, or any Commission rule, has occurred upon any premises occupied or operated by any such person or over which he or she has substantial control.

**WAC 230-03-085 Denying, suspending, or revoking an application, license**

We may deny, suspend, or revoke any application, license or permit, when the applicant, licensee, or anyone holding a substantial interest in the applicant's or licensee's business or organization:

(The following subsection applies.)

(1) Commits any act that constitutes grounds for denying, suspending, or revoking licenses or permits under RCW 9.46.075.

**WAC 230-15-730 Keeping an accounting system.**

(The following subsections apply.)

(1) House-banked card game licensees must keep and maintain a complete set of accounting records which we have approved before licensure. These records must include all receipts and disbursements of the licensee, including, at least, those related to gambling activities. Revenue, costs, and expenses.

(2) Licensees must keep legible, accurate, and complete records of all transactions relating to the revenues, costs, and expenses of the gambling operation. Licensees must keep these records in a format that ensures consistency, comparability, and effective disclosure of financial information.

IV.

The licensee has waived its right to a hearing, based on the terms and conditions of this Settlement Order. On February 18, 2011, the business was sold to new owners and the licensee stopped operating gambling activity. Therefore, the licensee agrees to the following:


