New Rule Changes Up for Discussion at the August Study Session

- Petition from the Public: Ashford Gaming LLC
 - For Mini-Baccarat, allowing players to make a wager on the player hand winning the next three consecutive games, or the banker hand winning the next three consecutive games.
 - Amendatory Section: **WAC 230-15-040** Requirements for authorized card games.
- Petition from the Public: Michael Marquess
 - Using match play coupons for Mini-Baccarat.
 - Amendatory Section: **WAC 230-15-453** Using match play or similar coupons in gambling promotions.
 - Alternative 1: No longer allowing match play coupons for mini-baccarat
 - Alternative 2: Repeal rule allowing match play coupons
