Community Impact & Charitable Contribution Background

Contributions are for Tribal fiscal year 2011

22 Tribes operating 28 casinos

**Calculations are based on net receipts
(Amount wagered less prizes paid)**

2011 total Tribal net receipts = \$2,120,982,000

Community Impact Contributions are:

Up to 2% of table game net receipts
paid to governmental agencies
impacted by the casino
