Petition from the Public: Charitable/nonprofit bingo and pull-tab licensees:
Ric Newgard (Seattle Junior Hockey) and Clyde Bock (Leon Sullivan Health Care Center)

- **Positive cash flow requirements for bingo and pull-tab games.**
 - Amended Section: WAC 230-10-375 Failing to maintain a positive cash flow.
 - Repealed Section: WAC 230-10-370 Adjusted cash flow limits for bingo.
 - Repealed Section: WAC 230-10-380 Relief reduction for minimum annual adjusted cash flow.

Staff Proposed Rule-Making:

- **Re-codification of WAC 230-14-047.**
 - Re-codify Section: WAC 230-14-047 Standards for electronic video pull-tab dispensers.

II. January 2015 Commission Meeting: Up for Discussion and Possible Filing

Staff Proposed Rule-Making:

- **Pilot project to test the regulatory and economic impacts of electronic raffle systems.**
 - New Section: WAC 230-11-999 Pilot project allowing the use of electronic raffle systems to conduct 50/50 raffles.
- **Refunds and non-sufficient funds payments.**
 - Amended Section: WAC 230-05-001 Prorating or refunding of fees.
 - Amended Section: WAC 230-05-010 Returned checks.
- **Online processes for licensees.**
 - Amended Section: WAC 230-05-015 Two-part payment plan for (~~license fees~~) licenses – online filing required.
 - Amended Section: WAC 230-06-125 Renew your license in a timely manner.
 - New Section: WAC 230-06-xxx Online filing and payments required with waivers available upon request for good cause.
- **No license required for manufacturers of amusement games.**
 - Amended Section: WAC 230-03-185 Applying for a manufacturer license.
 - Amended Section: WAC 230-06-110 Buying, selling, or transferring gambling equipment.
