

Match-n-Poker Blackjack Rules and Dealing Procedures

In addition to the regular 21 wager, a player may make a Match-n-Poker wager, betting that at least one of a player's initial two cards will exactly match the dealer's up card in rank or that a player's initial two cards combined with the dealer's up card will make a winning 3 card poker hand. Only the highest pay amount is awarded. Match-n-Poker can be played with 2, 4, 5, 6 or 8 standard 52 card decks. The house determines the minimum and maximum Match-n-Poker bet limits. Corresponding to the number of decks used, the house may determine which one of four Payout Tables to use.

First, all players make their regular 21 wager and optionally a Match-n-Poker wager. Then as in a regular 21 game, the dealer deals two cards face up to each player and two cards to himself, with one of the dealer's cards exposed as his up card. Next the dealer settles all Match-n-Poker wagers from the dealer's right to his left. Only the highest pay amount is awarded. The dealer collects any losing Match-n-Poker wagers and pays any winning Match-n-Poker wagers per the applicable following listed pay schedule. Immediately after paying the Match-n-Poker wager, the dealer pushes the Match-n-Poker wager along with the winnings toward the player and out of the way. The dealer then proceeds to play the regular 21 game.

The minimum Match-n-Poker bet is \$1, the house determines the max.

Casinos determine the number of decks to be used and select one of the following paytables:
