TIGER Pai Gow

How to Play

Tiger Pai Gow is played with a standard 52 card deck plus 1 joker. Total cards equals 53.

Tiger Pai Gow is made up of 3 games: the standard game of Pai Gow with an optional tie breaker and house choice of 2 of 3 side games.

SIDE BETS:

- 1) The Yin or Yang bets are based on wagering on the color Red or Black. (only one of these bets will be in the game)
- 2) The Seven Card Tiger bet is based on a 5 or 7 card hand ranking.

All players make a mandatory wager on the standard game of Pai Gow OR Pai Gow with Breaker card. (Rules on next pages)

All players have the option to wager on any of the offered side games. (Yin Bet or Yang Bet plus the 7 Card Tiger Bet)

After all wagers are placed, the dealer deals 7 cards to all 6 player positions and 7 cards to the dealer's position.

Total cards dealt equals 49.

There are 4 remaining cards.

- 1) If the Yin Bet is included in the game, dealer will use 1 card as the Breaker Card and the other 3 cards for the Yin bet. These 3 cards are laid out face down in front of the dealer.
- 2) If the Yang Bet is included in the game, dealer will use 1 card as the Breaker Card and the other 3 will be discarded.

After all players have arranged their cards into the two standard Pai Gow hands:

If the Yin Bet is included in the game, that game will be played and settled first. (Rules on next pages)

The dealer will now turn over his 7 cards and arrange them into 2 hands by house rules.

Dealer will then turn over the Breaker Card.

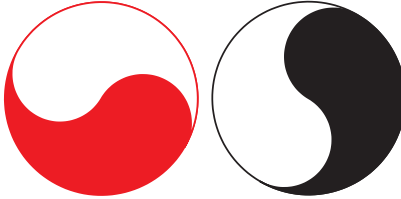
Dealer will turn over the cards of the first player to the dealer's right.

Dealer will play and settle player's Yang bet (if included in game), 7 Card Tiger bet and Pai Gow bet or Pai Gow with Breaker Bet. (Rules on next pages)

Dealer will continue to the next player in the same method until all bets are settled.

Yin Bet Odds

This is a Pai Gow side bet that uses the 4 remaining cards after all cards are dealt to the players and dealer. The dealer will use 1 card for the Breaker Card and the other 3 for the Yin game. To play, the player will wager on either Red or Black before any cards are dealt. If the majority of the 3 cards are the color the player wagered on, the player wins even money except when 1 of the 3 cards is the Joker, then all wagers lose.

Yang Bet Odds

This is a Pai Gow side bet that is based on the player's 7 dealt cards. The player wagers on either Red or Black before any cards are dealt. If the player's hand has 5 or more matches to the color he wagered on, the player wins from one of the pay tables below.

Odds

If player wagers on the 7 Card Tiger bet and the player's hand makes one of the rankings below, player wins. Envy bonus is paid to players who wagered on a round of play in which another wagering player hits one of the top 7 hands. Envy bonus is in play with a \$5 bet or higher.

BREAKER CARD

BET ON 1 ONLY



Player must wager on either standard Pai Gow or Pai Gow with Breaker Card.

Player must place one of these bets, but may not place both bets.

House Option: House may offer players only one bet: either standard Pai Gow or Pai Gow with Breaker card.

The Breaker Card is 1 of the 4 remaining cards in the deck after all cards are dealt to all 7 positions - 6 players and the dealer.

The Breaker Card will determine a winner if:

The player wagered on Pai Gow with Breaker Card.

The player wins one hand and the dealer wins one hand, which is known as a push.

The Breaker Card is played using the color of the card.

If the Breaker card is used, player or dealer with the most matches to the Breaker Card by color will win the game.

If player and dealer have the same number of matches to the Breaker Card by color, the game remains a push.

If the Breaker Card is the Joker, the game remains a push.

House option: The house has the option to pay a player a bonus if all 7 of the player's cards match the Breaker Card.
