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**FISCAL YEAR 2000
SUMMARY OF ACTIVITY AND TRENDS**

TOTAL LICENSED GAMBLING activity for the year increased by 5.3% from the previous year (\$896.9 million v \$851.8 million). The increase averaged 6.3% per year during the last three years. Nearly all of the growth continued to be in the card room area. However, the total number of licenses reporting activity actually decreased 1.3% from a year ago (3,425 v 3,470).

Please note: Tribal Gaming figures are not included in this annual report.

BINGO activity decreased by \$5.0 million in the fiscal year (down 3.1%), while the number of licenses reporting activity also decreased 5.1% (371 v 391). This activity decreased by \$23.7 million (13.0%) over the last three years (average of 4.3% per year). King, Pierce, Snohomish, and Spokane counties account for 58.6% of total state population and a similar share of total **BINGO** activity (54.6%). These counties' 1999 market share was 55.2%. [Note: As of 1-1-2000, a change in the law decreased the maximum local tax rate for Bingo and Raffle to 5% of net receipts, instead of 10% of net receipts.]

Combined **PUNCHBOARD AND PULL TAB** gross receipts decreased \$18.6 million (3.4%) this year to \$526.0 million. The number of licenses reporting activity decreased by less than one percent (0.9%) (2,236 v 2,257). While the combined activities have increased by \$6.4 million (1.2%) from three years ago, **PULL TABS** increased by \$10.1 million (2.0%) and **PUNCHBOARDS** declined by \$3.7 million (41.4%). The number of pull tab sets sold by **DISTRIBUTORS** decreased by 5.3% during the year (1,363,960 v 1,440,319). Effective 7-27-97, RCW 9.46.110 lowered the maximum rate that local jurisdictions can tax non-profit punchboard/pull tab activity from 5% of gross receipts to 10% of net receipts. (10% of net receipts would approximate 3.3% of gross receipts, assuming a two-thirds prize payout.) Local jurisdictions may continue to tax commercial operators up to 5% of gross receipts, or exercise their option to tax all operators up to 10% of net receipts.

Activity in **CARD ROOMS** increased by \$77.6 million (70.6%) over last year. The number of licenses reporting activity increased 18.7% (108 v 91). There has been an increase from three years ago of \$169.7 million (948.6%, an average of 316.2% per year), which is primarily due to house-banked card rooms. Prior to 1990, card room activity showed a flat growth pattern. During 1990-1992, higher growth rates occurred and were attributed primarily to the authorization of Washington Blackjack in April of 1990. Starting in 1993, card room activity increased only slightly each year, until a dip occurred in 1996. In June of 1996, new legislation allowed up to 15 tables. In June of 1997, legislation added house banking.

On 6-30-99, 47 house banked card rooms were open in the test program (which ended May 1, 2000).

On 6-30-00, the number of house banked card rooms open had risen to 54.

RAFFLE activity decreased \$226,818 (3.3%) from last year. The number of raffle licenses reporting activity went up 1.7% (545 v 536). Average net income decreased 7.5% (\$5,744 v \$6,208).

The number of **FUND RAISING EVENTS** declined by 39.1% this year (39 v 64). This continues a trend demonstrated since 1986. Total gross receipts for this activity decreased by \$33,736 (26.0%) compared to last year, while average net income per event increased by 22.9% (\$1,131 v \$920).

COMMERCIAL AMUSEMENT GAME activity decreased \$8,362,381 (31.2%) from last year's level. The number of commercial amusement game licenses reporting activity decreased by 6.7% (97 v 104). The two largest FY99 amusement game operators reported approximately \$9.1 million less in FY00 gross receipts, after they combined operations.

Note: Some operators serve several locations under revenue sharing agreements, but report only once.

- c) "net win" in house-banked card rooms (starting July 1997).


"Rake" is a percentage of the total amount wagered by players during one hand.

"Net Win" describes the total money taken in by house-banked card rooms, less the amounts paid out in winning hands.


"Prizes Paid" include tournament awards [but NOT winning hands from house-banked card rooms].

ALL GAMBLING ACTIVITIES *









DISTRIBUTION OF GAMBLING ACTIVITY



By Type of Activity






GROSS GAMBLING RECEIPTS REPORTED - \$896,862,342

By Type of Activity






NET INCOME REPORTED - \$102,639,388




DISTRIBUTION OF GROSS GAMBLING RECEIPTS

FOR FISCAL YEAR ENDED JUNE 30, 2000








