

State Problem Gambling Program

2021-2023 Budget – \$1.61M



SFY 2022 – PG Treatment Services (\$482K)

(First year of biennium – 66% of total funding of \$703,500 for SFY 2022 before \$150K added)

328 adult client cases received treatment services

- Average cost per client = \$1466
- Included an average of 1 assessment + 16-17 sessions

135 new clients assessed

79% admitted into outpatient services



March is Problem Gambling Awareness Month










March is Problem Gambling Awareness Month
