This approval letter is being issued to amend information to the March 7, 2012 approval letter. The Break Out Box (BOB) software version in the original letter was incorrectly identified.

Thank you for requesting approval of the Mercury 360 Roulette Wheel, Cammegh EyeBall, and Billboard Display. We have completed our review.

The Mercury 360 Roulette Wheel, Cammegh EyeBall and Billboard Display are approved for use in Washington State with the following requirements:

- Recommend the Operators keep the rotor speed between 10-30 rpm for accurate display and recording of game outcome/ball drops.
- The keyboard and mouse must be disconnected from the Billboard controller during game play.
- All open ports on the PC box and the BOB be disabled or sealed to prevent unauthorized access to game results and event logs or unapproved network use.
- Provide information to the Operator on the minimum ball speed or rotations needed to provide a winning number result.
- Since the Cammegh Pit Boss was not submitted for testing, it may not be used in conjunction with the equipment.
