Manufacturer Requirements:

- Ensure a stamp, seal or label identifying the manufacturer, city and state where the PTVM Lite 31.5-017 Pull Tab Vending Machine is manufactured is displayed on the pull tab dispensing device (WAC 230-14-045).
- The bill acceptor must inform the player if it does not return change (WAC 230-14-045).

Operator Requirements:

- Ensure the price of a single pull tab does not exceed five dollars as required by RCW 9.46.110(2)(b), effective June 11, 2020.
- Ensure the entire pull tab series is put out for play as required by WAC 230-14-055(2)(c).
- Follow all WAC rules related to the operation and recordkeeping of pull tabs.

Any modifications made to the PTVM Lite 31.5-017 - Maxim Mini-Max Pull Tab Vending Machine software, or associated equipment must be submitted to us for additional testing and review. We reserve the right to investigate and reevaluate the PTVM Lite equipment if we determine that such a review is required to ensure compliance.
