Thank you for requesting approval of the Blaze Craps version 2.2.5.5. We have completed our review. Blaze Craps is approved to be operated in Tribal Casinos only in Washington. It is not approved for use in commercial non-tribal casinos.

Manufacturer Requirements:

Any modifications made to the Blaze Craps version 2.2.5.5, must be submitted to us for additional testing and review. We reserve the right to investigate and re-evaluate this equipment if we determine that such a review is necessary to ensure compliance with tribal state compacts or rules and laws of Washington.

<u>Tribal Casino Implementation:</u>

Ensure casino internal controls and game rules are revised to include this new equipment and procedures, and they are approved by the Tribal Gaming Agency and concurred with by the Washington State Gambling Commission prior to installation of Blaze Craps.

Please notify Special Agent Julie Kerkof at <u>Julie.kerkof@wsgc.wa.gov</u> at least 2 weeks prior to any scheduled installation of the Blaze Craps into a tribal casino.
