## Overview of the Rules

### Introduction

Pai Wow Bonus is an optional side bet for pai gow poker. The bet considers three of the cards remaining after the dealer distributes all pai gow hands. Bettors win when those three cards, called the Pai Wow hand, contain at least a pair.

### Dealing Procedures

Players place a standard pai gow wager and may place the optional Pai Wow Bonus wager within posted table limits.

1. If dealt by hand:
  - a. Once the dealer distributes all pai gow hands, he will place the four remaining cards face-down in the marked area on the layout, then burn the top card. Only three cards will remain.
  - b. The dealer then follows house procedures for pai gow poker.
  - c. The dealer should resolve all pai gow bets and remove all cards.\*
  - d. The dealer should then reveal the Pai Wow hand and resolve all bonus bets.
2. If dealt with an ACE shuffler:
  - a. The ACE dispenses seven seven-card hands. The dealer should place player hands in front of each betting position and his own hand in front of the chip tray.
  - b. When the ACE dispenses the final four cards, the dealer will place them face-down in the marked area. The dealer will burn the top card; only three cards remain.
  - c. The dealer then follows house procedures for pai gow poker.
  - d. The dealer should resolve all pai gow bets and remove all cards.\*
  - e. The dealer should then reveal the Pai Wow hand and resolve all bonus bets.

Note: The Joker assumes the same value in the three-card hand as it does in the underlying pai gow game in play at the casino.

\* Optional. Casinos may first resolve the Pai Wow hand.

Natural straight flush	25 to 1
3 of a Kind	20 to 1
Wild straight flush	10 to 1
Straight	4 to 1
Flush	3 to 1
Pair	1 to 1
House advantage:	5.48%
Hit Frequency:	27.52%

\* Mini Royal may include Joker.

In PWB-03, the Joker is used as an Ace, or to complete a straight or a flush.
