Dear Ms. Kimball,

We have reviewed the changes made to Royal Match 21. Based on our review of the documentation we received from SHFL Entertainment, the Washington State Gambling Commission will approve the game under the conditions listed below:

- The game shall be played and operated under the terms and conditions set forth under the "Royal Match 21 Deluxe Rules of Play" you provided on January 9, 2014, and are enclosed.

Commercial Card Rooms

- Commercial card room operators seeking to operate this game must first submit their internal controls and receive approval from the Commission prior to implementing.
- Manufacturers and distributors of graphic layouts and/or any other equipment associated with the game must be licensed by the state prior to the sale of the equipment.

Tribal Casinos

- Each Tribal Gaming Operation must request and obtain approval from their respective Tribal Gaming Agencies (TGA).
- Before TGA allows your game to operate, they will seek concurrence from our agency as well.
- In addition to your approved rules, the Tribal submission to us must include all supplemental information required by Tribal-State Compact Appendix A, Section 18.





“Deluxe” Version

Royal Match 21 Deluxe is a standard house-banked blackjack game but with an optional bonus wager. All rules pertaining to standard blackjack as posted on the WSGC’s website remain the same and are not altered in this game.

RULES OF PLAY

1. Royal Match is an optional bonus bet for blackjack.
2. Royal Match considers the first two cards the player receives. If they are the same suit, the player wins.
3. Players then have the option to collect their proceeds or leave up to all of them on the Royal Match betting spot.
4. Sample paytable below:

First two cards	Pays
Royal Match (King-Queen suited)	15 to 1
Two Suited Cards	2 to 1

5. To begin each round, players must make their standard blackjack wagers and, the optional Royal Match wager.
6. The dealer then follows house procedures for blackjack
7. Once players have two cards, the dealer settles Royal Match wagers in one of two ways.
 - a. When the cards are dealt face up, the Royal Match wagers will be settled immediately after everyone receives their first two (2) cards.

- b. When the cards are dealt face down, the Royal Match wagers will be settled on a hand to hand basis, as the dealer goes from left to right asking for hit/stand determinations.
 - c. If players have two suited cards, they win according to the payable. If their first two cards are not suited, players lose their Royal Match wager.
8. Players who win the Royal Match 21 Deluxe bet will be asked by the dealer if they want to receive all of the proceeds from their winnings or choose to leave all or a portion of the winnings on the Royal Match 21 Deluxe spot. The Royal Match 21 Deluxe spot and Blackjack spot are considered separate wagers and are decided upon the outcome of the blackjack hand. Thus, if he eventually splits, the Player may match the entire Royal Match 21 Deluxe wager and blackjack wager. If he doubles down, he may match the entire Royal Match 21 Deluxe wager and blackjack wager (unless he chooses to 'double down for less' as per casino rules). The Player may also leave all or a portion of his winning Royal Match 21 Deluxe wager on the Royal Match 21 Deluxe bet spot if his winning hand was a Blackjack (Ace-King). Players do not touch the money; the dealer does it for them.
9. If the dealer has blackjack, players must collect their Royal Match 21 Deluxe proceeds; they do not have the option of leaving their winnings on the Royal Match 21 Deluxe spot.

Operators cannot allow wagering limits to exceed the authorized limits set out in WAC 230-15-040 and WAC 230-15-140.
