We have reviewed the changes made to Bet The Set 21. Based on our review of the documentation we received from SHFL Entertainment, the Washington State Gambling Commission will approve the game under the conditions listed below:

- The game shall be played and operated under the terms and conditions set forth under the "Bet The Set 21 Deluxe Rules of Play" you provided on January 9, 2014, and are enclosed.

**Commercial Card Rooms**

- Commercial card room operators seeking to operate this game must first submit their internal controls and receive approval from the Commission prior to implementing.
- Manufacturers and distributors of graphic layouts and/or any other equipment associated with the game must be licensed by the state prior to the sale of the equipment.

**Tribal Casinos**

- Each Tribal Gaming Operation must request and obtain approval from their respective Tribal Gaming Agencies (TGA).
- Before TGA allows your game to operate, they will seek concurrence from our agency as well.

In addition to your approved rules, the Tribal submission to us must include all supplemental information required by Tribal-State Compact Appendix A, Section 18.



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- Manufacturers and distributors of graphic layouts and/or any other equipment associated with the game must be certified by the state and licensed by the Tribe prior to the sale of the equipment.

Thank you for your cooperation and willingness to comply with the gambling laws of Washington State.

# Deluxe Version Training Manual

*Bet the Set 21 Deluxe is a standard house-banked blackjack game but with an optional bonus wager. All rules pertaining to standard blackjack as posted on the WSGC's website remain the same and are not altered in this game.*

## Introduction

*Bet the Set "21"* is an optional bonus bet for blackjack that considers the first two cards a player receives. If the player's first two cards are a pair or suited pair, the player wins. The player's hand is independent of the dealer's hand and is unaffected by the dealer's blackjack. *Bet the Set "21"* uses a standard 52-card deck. Follow standard house procedures for the total number of decks to be used.

## Dealing Procedures

Because dealing procedures vary by jurisdiction, please refer to the appropriate gaming agency for regulations specific to your jurisdiction. It is recommended that *Bet the Set "21"* be dealt with a single or double-deck automatic shuffler for single or double-deck games, such as SHFL entertainment's, Deck Mate®, or a multi-deck continuous automatic shuffler, such as SHFL entertainment's one2six™.

1. Each player makes a standard blackjack wager and the *Bet the Set* wager.
  - a. If casino rules allow, a player may play multiple hands.
  - b. A player playing multiple hands may place a *Bet the Set* wager on none, one or all of his hands.
2. The dealer then follows house procedures for dealing blackjack.
3. Once each player has received two cards, the dealer settles all *Bet the Set* wagers according to house procedures. If a player's first two cards are a pair or suited pair, they win according to the posted payable. If the player's first two cards are not a pair, they lose their *Bet the Set* wager.
4. If players win the *Bet the Set* wager, they have the following option:
  - a. Take all the proceeds from the Bet the Set bet down; or
  - b. Leave any portion up to all of the winnings on the Bet the Set betting spot.
5. The dealer will ask the players if they want to receive all of the proceeds from their winnings or choose to leave all or a portion of the winnings on the Bet the Set spot. The Bet the Set spot and Blackjack spot are considered separate wagers and are decided upon the outcome of the blackjack hand. Thus, if he eventually splits, the Player may match the entire Bet the Set wager and blackjack wager. If he doubles down, he may match the entire Bet the Set wager and blackjack wager (unless he chooses to 'double down for less' as per casino rules).
6. Note: The dealer will check for blackjack before players make the decision to collect their proceeds or add them to their main bet. If the dealer has blackjack, players that win the Bet the Set wager must collect their proceeds.

*Operators cannot allow wagering limits to exceed the authorized limits set out in WAC 230-15-040 and WAC 230-15-140.*
