Dear Mr. Manning,

Thank you for submitting the DC Super Heroes amusement game, manufactured by Andamiro Inc., to us for review. In the information submitted, it was noted that the game has been modified for Washington State. Specifically, the bonus plays section displayed on the game has been modified to award bonus tokens dropped onto the playing field instead of bonus plays.

We have completed our review. It is my understanding the game plays as follows:

The players press the play button to rotate the large wheel on the back wall of the cabinet and drop a token. The goal is to drop the token through the "Bonus Drop" area which will stop the bonus spinner above it. There is a moving light that stops when the coin goes through the bonus drop area. The player receives the prize displayed next to where the light stops. This will drop bonus tokens or Super Hero cards onto the playfield. Players receive the cards pushed off the playfield or tickets as a prize. If the player collects all character cards they win the bonus displayed on the game.

The DC Super Heroes game meets the definition of an amusement game (RCW 9.46.0201) and is approved for use as a Group 8 Penny Fall (WAC 230-13-050) amusement game in Washington State.

Please be advised that any modifications to the DC Super Heroes amusement game software or associated equipment must be provided to us for additional testing and review. In addition, amusement games operated in Washington must not have settings that allow the operator to control the outcome of the game (auto percentaging). The approval of this equipment may be rescinded at any time if problems are found by the Commission or changes to the Washington
