Thank you for submitting The Pac-Man Swirl game to us for review. Special Agents Karen Rea and Sonja Dolson have completed their review. It is my understanding the game plays as follows:

Players time the release of balls in the game to land into the revolving holes. The holes have various ticket values associated with them. The player wins the number of tickets associated with the hole the ball lands in. If a player lands the ball into the big win bonus hole, they win the bonus displayed on the top of the game. The game allows up to 4 players to play at the same time.

The Pac-Man Swirl game is approved for use as Group V, hand/eye coordination (WAC 230-13-035) amusement game in Washington State.

Please be advised that any modifications to the Pac Man Swirl amusement game software or associated equipment must be provided to us for additional testing and review. In addition, the approval of this equipment may be rescinded at any time if problems are found by the Commission or changes to the Washington Administrative Code (WAC) impact this approval.
