Re: Wheel of Fortune – Version numbers: v. 1.16 and v.1.23

Dear Mr. Struhs,

Thank you for submitting the Wheel of Fortune amusement game to us for review. Special Agents Karen Rea and Sonja Dolson have completed their review. It is my understanding the game plays as follows:

The object of the Wheel of Fortune game is to select letters used in the puzzle and then solve the wheel of fortune puzzle. Players win tickets for each accurate letter selected and tickets for solving the puzzle. The player uses hand-eye coordination when spinning the small wheel. The speed of the spin on the small wheel activates the large wheel which stops on value that will be awarded for each accurate letter the player chooses. Several different wheel variations may be used with this game depending on the cost per play.

You were advised that the maximum wager is \$3.50 and maximum prize is \$500 for locations where minors are allowed to play in Washington. In addition, you were notified that internet access on this game is not allowed and you assured staff there is no internet access capability on the Wheel of Fortune game.

The Wheel of Fortune game meets the definition of an amusement game (RCW 9.46.0201) and is approved for use as a Group V, hand/eye coordination (WAC 230-13-035) amusement game in Washington State.

Please be advised that any modifications to the Wheel of Fortune amusement game software or associated equipment must be provided to us for additional testing and review. In addition, the approval of this equipment may be rescinded at any time if problems are found by the Commission or changes to the Washington Administrative Code (WAC) impact this approval.
