Thank you for requesting approval of the i-Score Display Device v1.6.02 (i-Score) upgrade. We have completed our review.

The i-Score v1.6.02 that works in conjunction with the i-Shoe Auto v2.0.141 (approved May 7, 2010 and approved on February 23, 2012 for use with Dragon Bonus and Dragon Bonus Progress) is approved for use in Washington State. We are approving the i-Score v1.6.02 with the following requirements:

- A user login and password should be added to start up the PC Table Processor in order to limit access by unauthorized users.
- If the optional i-Shoe Auto is used with the i-Score Display Device, the keypad should only be attached to the i-Shoe during configuration of the display.
- If the optional i-Shoe Auto is used with the i-Score Display Device all requirements associated with the i-Shoe Auto remain in effect.
- It cannot be used with any other electronic or mechanical shoe unless authorized and approved by us.



Thank you for requesting approval of the use of Dragon Bonus and Dragon Bonus Progressive with i-Shoe Auto v2.0.141 and i-Score Display Device v1.5.19. We have completed our review.

The i-Shoe Auto v2.0.141 and i-Score Display Device v1.5.19 is approved for use in Washington State with Dragon Bonus and Dragon Bonus Progressive (rules submitted on January 26, 2012, attached) with the following requirements:

- The card recognition feature can only be used with Mini Baccarat, Baccarat, Dragon Bonus, and Dragon Bonus Progressive.
