This letter is an amendment to the attached approval letter dated January 22, 2008 to provide further clarification on the ACE Version 6.54PPG.

The January 22, 2008 correspondence stated, "As for the ACE Shuffler Version 6.54PPG, approval is granted but we require the dealer to wash all decks prior to inserting them into the ACE shuffler."

We are amending that approval to allow the ACE Version 6.54PPG with the following requirements:

- The dealer must wash all new decks prior to inserting them into the ACE; and
- The dealer must shuffle the deck before placing the cards into the ACE after every hand.

As for the card game, the Washington State Gambling Commission (Commission) will approve the game under the conditions listed below:

Commercial Card Rooms:

- The game shall be played and operated under the terms and conditions set forth under the "Fortune Pai Gow Poker Progressive – Rules of Play" you provided.
- Commercial card room operators seeking to operate this game must first submit their internal controls and receive approval from the Commission prior to implementing.

Tribal Casinos:

- The game shall be played and operated under the terms and conditions set forth under the "Fortune Pai Gow Poker Progressive – Rules of Play" you provided.



- Each Tribal Gaming Operation must request and obtain approval from their respective Tribal Gaming Agencies (TGA).
- Before TGA allows your game to operate, they will seek concurrence from our agency as well.
- In addition to your approved rules, the Tribal submission to us must include all supplemental information required by Tribal-State Compact Appendix A, Section 18.
- Manufacturers and distributors of graphic layouts and/or any other equipment associated with the game must be certified by the state and licensed by the Tribe prior to the sale of the equipment.

Any modifications to this game may affect this approval. Contact the Commission should you contemplate modifications. 
