Dear Ms. Zarach:

Thank you for requesting approval of the MD2-CR (Linux) Multi-Deck Card Shuffler Version 4.0.062, with CardRec Version 4.0.0017, and RNG Version 3.0.006 (MD2-CR Shuffler). We have completed our review.

The MD2-CR Shuffler is approved for use in Washington State. We are approving the MD2-CR Shuffler with the following requirements:

- You must provide a latch that can be secured over the Ethernet port on the back of the shuffler.

The operator:

- Must secure the latch over the Ethernet port on the back of the shuffler.
- Must bolt the outer casing to the device and secure the shuffler to the card table so it is physically inaccessible except for the menu screen, loading, and shuffling docks.
- Must restrict access to the password to enable the Card Recognition Mode to a supervisor or above.
- Must ensure the MD2-CR Shuffler can be viewed by surveillance as required by WAC 230-15-180 and Tribal-State Compact.
