
Regarding the "Multiplier" function itself, this differs enough from traditional Keno that I am approving your system for submission as a "Keno/lottery type" game for use only in Tribal Gaming Operations.

This will require your game rules and internal controls to be submitted to our agency by way of a Tribal Gaming Agency (i.e. Tribal sponsor). Our agency will have sixty days to agree or disagree with the play and regulation of the game. If a dispute arises with respect to the nature of the game, security issues, rules of play or training and enforcement associated with regulation, the state and Tribe can negotiate the issues or go to arbitration.

- Electronic Gambling Lab representative Rodney Joubert after consultation with representatives of your company has concluded the keno.exe file controls the features of the "Multiplier" so there are no separate files for this feature or signatures that need to be added for this approval.
