Thank you for requesting approval of the i-Score Display Device v1.5.19. We have completed our review.

The i-Score Display Device v1.5.19 is approved for use in Washington State with the following requirements:

- A user login and password should be added to start up the PC Table Processor in order to limit access by unauthorized users.
- If the optional i-Shoe Auto is used with the i-Score Display Device, the keypad should only be attached to the i-Score during configuration of the display.
- If the optional i-Shoe Auto is used with the i-Score Display Device, all requirements noted in the July 9, 2010 approval letter (attached) remain in effect.




