Executive Session

Chair Sizemore called the meeting to order at 8:40 AM and announced that the next 2 hours would be dedicated to executive session, where the commissioners would discuss potential agency litigation, including tribal negotiations. He announced that the public meeting would reconvene at 11:00 AM.
Executive Session adjourned at 10:40 AM.

Public Meeting Call to Order

Chair Sizemore welcomed everyone back from executive session and began the public meeting at 11:06 AM. Chair Sizemore acknowledged a moment of silence to recognize law enforcement officers who were lost in the line of duty since our last meeting.

There were five people in the audience.

Tab 1

Commissioner Troyer moved to approve the consent agenda as presented by staff.

Commissioner Patterson seconded the motion.

The motion passed 3:0

Commissioner Levy had not yet joined the meeting.

Director's Report

Director Trujillo gave a short report on the Coronavirus Pandemic and the plans the agency has in place so far. He stressed that the agency would post regular updates on our website regarding potential adjustments to operating hours. He reminded everyone that March is Problem

Gambling Awareness Month and that the Problem Gambling Taskforce is planning to meet on April 25 for the next scheduled meeting.

Tab 2

Staff-Proposed Rule Making-Fee Simplification; Amendments

Ashlie Laydon, Rules Coordinator (RC), presented the materials for this tab. RC Laydon reported that since the new fee structure started; staff has identified changes and proposed rule language changes. RC Laydon and staff recommend filing changes for further discussion effective 31 days after filing.

Chair Sizemore asked for public comment. There was no public comment.

Commissioner Troyer moved to direct staff to file draft language as proposed by staff.

Commissioner Patterson seconded the motion.

The motion passed 4:0

Tab 3

Staff-Proposed Rule Making- Fee Simplification; Repeals

RC Laydon presented the materials for this tab. RC Laydon reported that at the January commission meeting, staff presented language for rules that needed to be repealed. RC Laydon and staff recommend filing the repeals for final action.

Commissioner Troyer moved to approve repeal language as proposed by staff.

Commissioner Patterson seconded the motion.

The motion passed 4:0

Chair Sizemore asked for public comments. There was no public comment.

Tab 4

Petition to Initiate Rule-Making-50/50 Electronic Raffles

Mari Hortita, NHL Seattle; Amber Carter, Seattle Mariners; and Brian Considine, Legal and Legislative Manager (LLM) presented the materials for this tab. **LLM Considine** introduced the petitioners to the commissioners. **Ms. Hortita** is Vice President of Community Engagement and Philanthropy for NHL Seattle and Amber Carter represents the Seattle Mariners. Ms. Hortita provided two handouts to the commissioners (now posted on the agency website) and the two representatives presented on behalf of NHL Seattle, the Seattle Mariners, Seattle Sounders FC and the Seattle Seahawks. Ms. Hortita and Ms. Carter requested the commissioners accept their petition to enter into rule-making and create rules allowing the petitioners' nonprofit foundations to hold 50/50 raffles using electronic equipment during home sports events. Money raised by the petitioners' nonprofit foundations will go towards charitable causes, including homelessness, diversity and inclusion initiatives, and hockey-related youth programs for marginalized youth in the community. **Commissioner Troyer** asked if all sports teams have their own foundation that money goes through, or does the money go straight to another organization. **Ms. Hortita** answered, "I believe sometimes it goes directly to another organization, but at least in the NHL, generally it goes to the foundation and then it's distributed out. I think there are certain nights like hockey fights, cancer nights where it may go directly to a particular nonprofit." **Commissioner Troyer** asked if Ms. Hortita knew what percentage went to the organizations for administrative costs and overhead. Ms. Hortita will get back to

Commissioner Troyer with that answer. **LLM Considine** added that each team has its own foundation with its own focus. Staff can, however, work closely with the petitioners to gather information related to nonprofit operations during rule-making for the commissioners to review, including projected revenues, charities served, and parts of the state served by each charity. He added that Staff recommends that the commissioners accept the petition with the understanding that the raffle equipment will need to be submitted for testing and review during the rule process before any rules can be finalized. Petitioners are aware of this requirement and they do not have any objections.

Chair Sizemore asked for public comments. There were no public comments.

Commissioner Troyer moved to approve the petition and initiate rule-making as proposed by staff regarding the 50/ 50 electronic raffles for professional sports venues.

Commissioner Patterson seconded the motion.

The motion passed 4:0

Tab 5

2020 Legislative Update

Brian Considine, LLLM, presented the materials for this tab. LLM Considine discussed highlights of the current 2020 session, including passage of: the agency's two request bills, SB 6119 and SB 6120; the pull-tab wager increase bill, SB 6357; and the tribal-only sports gambling bill, ESHB 2638. LLM Considine thanked Senator Conway for sponsoring the agency bills passed by the Legislature and the supplemental budget proviso providing \$500,000 for a problem gambling prevalence study. He also thanked Representative Kloba and Senator Holy for their support and assistance during the 2020 legislative session. **Chair Sizemore** recognized LLM Considine for his tireless work during the 2020 session and **Commissioner Patterson** concurred and thanked him as well.

Public Comment

There was no additional public comment.

In closing, **Chair Sizemore** mentioned that the April Gambling Commission meeting is being planned and to watch the Gambling Commission's website for details.

The meeting reconvened and adjourned at 12:07 PM.




Background/Structure

General Information:

Acres Manufacturing Company (Acres) incorporated in Washington State on May 3, 2018.

Acres manufactures and develops systems that connect to electronic gaming machines to provide player tracking, loyalty, bonusing, accounting and marketing services. Upon approval, they intend to provide their software and equipment to Class III facilities in Washington through Acres Bonusing, Inc., a licensed distributor.

Acres does not hold a gaming license in any other jurisdiction. However, sole owner John Acres, through his other gaming companies, has held licenses in Nevada, New Jersey, Michigan, Oregon, Minnesota and a variety of Tribal jurisdictions.

Part II Licensing Investigations Summary

A Special Agent from the Commission's Licensing Unit conducted a criminal history and financial investigation for suitability in accordance with RCW 9.46 and WAC 230. The Special Agent went on-site to Las Vegas, Nevada, to conduct their investigation, which included verifying the ownership structure, reviewing financial and business records, reviewing manufacturing processes, and conducting interviews. The investigation found:


- No unreported people or businesses involved (i.e. substantial interest holders);
- No undisclosed ownership or undisclosed involvement in other activities/businesses;
- No disqualifying administrative history;
- All funding sources were disclosed; and
- All substantial interest holders qualify to hold a license.





Pre-COVID-19 Financial Projection


