




### Amusement Game Licensees Will:

Pay a base fee at licensure/renewal

Pay a fee for each location

File quarterly gross revenue reports

Pay quarterly license fees



#### **Pay base fee at time of licensure/renewal**

Operators pay a base fee and an additional fee for each operating location (up to the maximum amount).

#### **Submit quarterly reports and pay quarterly fees**

Fees = Rate x Gross Gambling Receipts (GGR)

Base fee is credited towards quarterly fees due

#### **Operating locations must be approved**

Amusement games cannot be placed until a license has been issued. Operators will submit a form to add or remove a location. Some locations will temporarily operate without a license until the operator is due for renewal under the new rules.

#### **Notify WSGC of location changes**

Operators use a WSGC form to add or remove locations. Operators must notify WSGC within 30 days of removing all games from a location.

#### **ID Stamps no longer required**

Redemption and amusement games no longer need to have ID stamps on the machines

**Carnival operators and amusement parks/centers must pay a fee and receive a license for each location where amusement/redemption games are operated.**
