**ORDER OF DISMISSAL
WITH PREJUDICE**

On July 10, 2012, the Director of the Washington State Gambling Commission issued Administrative Charges against Daniel L. Dunn, of Everett, for the suspension or revocation of his Card Room Employee license to conduct gambling activities. The charges were issued due to pending criminal charges filed in Snohomish County.

Following the issuance of the Administrative Charges, the Snohomish County Superior Court entered an Order of Dismissal on August 24, 2012, for Mr. Dunn's criminal charges.

The prosecutor's Motion and Affidavit for Order of Dismissal stated that the parties agreed to suppress material evidence after the defendant was stopped in the car he was driving. The prosecutor also cited to potential credibility issues regarding the testimony of the alleged victim in this case. As a result, there was insufficient evidence to convict the defendant beyond a reasonable doubt. Accordingly, Commission staff's Administrative Charges against Daniel L. Dunn, should be dismissed with prejudice.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Commission's Notice of Administrative Charges be dismissed with prejudice.
