**I. FINDINGS OF FACT**

A. License Information

1. The Washington State Gambling Commission issued Licensee Tram T. Nguyen License number: 68-17319, authorizing Public Card Room Employee activity at the Chips Casino and the Palace Casino, both in Lakewood.

2. Ms. Tram Nguyen's license, which expires on February 2, 2017, was issued subject to the licensee's compliance with state gambling laws and Commission rules.

B. Case Number CR 2016-00122

1. As of January 26, 2016, Ms. Tram Nguyen had \$4,900 in outstanding checks.

2. Bank records demonstrate Ms. Tram Nguyen wrote numerous checks ranging from \$500 to \$1000 to five casinos while gambling on June 3, 2014 without having the funds in her bank account to cover the checks.

3. These checks were written at approximately five different casinos: Silver Dollar Renton, Great American Lakewood, Chips Casino, Riverside Casino, Great American Kent, over the course of several hours on June 3, 2014.
