FINAL ORDER OF THE

10 Licensee.

11 These matters having come before the Washington State Gambling Commission  
12 (Commission) on May 12, 2017 and the Commission makes the following Findings of Fact,  
13 Conclusions of Law, and issues its Final Order:

14 **I. FINDINGS OF FACT**

15 1. The Washington State Gambling Commission issued Licensee Christina R.  
16 Jimenez, License No. 68-09118, authorizing Public Card Room Employee activity at the  
17 Wizard's Casino in Burien, Washington.

18 2. Ms. Jimenez's license, which expires on June 9, 2017, was issued subject to the  
19 licensee's compliance with state gambling laws and Commission rules.

20 3. In 2011, the Commission issued Ms. Jimenez a PCRE license.

21 4. In June, 2015, Ms. Jimenez disclosed active warrants on her renewal application.  
22 The Commission instructed her to have the warrants quashed in 30 days, but Ms. Jimenez did  
23 not comply with the instruction until much later.

24 5. In May, 2016, Ms. Jimenez was charged with Driving While License Suspended  
25 Third Degree in Federal Way Municipal Court, and in June, 2016, a warrant was issued for  
26 failure to appear. Ms. Jimenez never reported the DWLS 3 charge to the Commission.

2           Reconsideration: RCW 34.05.470 and WAC 230-17-140 provide that a party may file a  
3 petition for reconsideration of a final order. A petition for reconsideration must be received no  
4 later than thirteen (13) days after the date this final order is mailed. Any motion for  
5 reconsideration must state the specific grounds supporting the party's request for  
6 reconsideration.

7           Stay of Final Order: Filing for reconsideration does not stay the effectiveness of this  
8 Order. WAC 230-17-145 provides that a party may petition the Commission for a stay of a final  
9 order. Any petition for a stay should be received by the Commission within thirteen (13) days  
10 after the date this final order is mailed.

11           Judicial Review: RCW 34.05.542 provides that a party may appeal this final order by  
12 filing a petition for judicial review within thirty (30) days after service of this order. A petition  
13 for judicial review must be filed with the appropriate superior court and served upon both the  
14 Commission and the Office of the Attorney General.

15           Service: This Order was served on you three days after it was deposited in the United  
16 States Postal Service regular mail, excluding the date of mailing. WAC 230-17-035.
