Enclosed is an Order of Default entered by the Commission on October 12, 2017, revoking your license/certification to conduct gambling activities. This action occurred because you did not timely respond by requesting a hearing to the administrative charges filed on June 2, 2017 against your gambling license/certification.

You have the right to move to vacate this Order. If you do so, we must receive your request by the 10th day after the Order was mailed. Your motion must include the specific grounds upon which relief is requested and must be submitted to:

You also have the right to submit a Petition for Judicial Review. If you do this, you must submit it within 30 days of the date the Order was mailed. RCW 34.05.514 explains where you must file this petition and RCW 34.05.546 explains what information your Petition must include.

11 These matters having come before the Washington State Gambling Commission
12 (Commission) on October 12, 2017 and the Commission makes the following Findings of Fact,
13 Conclusions of Law, and issues its Final Order:

14 **I. FINDINGS OF FACT**

15 1. The Washington State Gambling Commission issued Justin O. Madison License
16 number: 69-32979, authorizing Public Card Room Employee activity at Roman Casino in
17 Seattle, Washington.

18 2. Mr. Madison's license, which expired on June 30, 2017, was issued subject to the
19 licensee's compliance with state gambling laws and Commission rules.

20 3. On March 16, 2017, Mr. Madison was working as a security guard at Palace
21 Casino, where his duties included removing drop boxes from gaming tables at the end of the day.

22 4. On the above date, surveillance showed \$300 cash sticking out of the spring-
23 loaded end of one of the drop boxes Mr. Madison was removing.

24 5. Surveillance also showed Mr. Madison pull the \$300 cash out of the drop box and
25 hold it in his left hand, then proceed to take the drop boxes to another pit. Surveillance did not
26 show Mr. Madison put any cash back into the drop box.

1 **NOTICE**

2 Reconsideration: RCW 34.05.470 and WAC 230-17-140 provide that a party may file a
3 petition for reconsideration of a final order. A petition for reconsideration must be received no
4 later than thirteen (13) days after the date this final order is mailed. Any motion for
5 reconsideration must state the specific grounds supporting the party's request for
6 reconsideration.

7 Stay of Final Order: Filing for reconsideration does not stay the effectiveness of this
8 Order. WAC 230-17-145 provides that a party may petition the Commission for a stay of a final
9 order. Any petition for a stay should be received by the Commission within thirteen (13) days
10 after the date this final order is mailed.

11 Judicial Review: RCW 34.05.542 provides that a party may appeal this final order by
12 filing a petition for judicial review within thirty (30) days after service of this order. A petition
13 for judicial review must be filed with the appropriate superior court and served upon both the
14 Commission and the Office of the Attorney General.

15 Service: This Order was served on you three days after it was deposited in the United
16 States Postal Service regular mail, excluding the date of mailing. WAC 230-17-035.
