Enclosed is an Order of Default entered by the Commission on January 11, 2018, revoking your license/certification to conduct gambling activities. This action occurred because you did not attend the prehearing conference on October 20, 2017 concerning your gambling license/certification.

You have the right to move to vacate this Order. If you do so, we must receive your request by the 10th day after the Order was mailed. Your motion must include the specific grounds upon which relief is requested and must be submitted to:

You also have the right to submit a Petition for Judicial Review. If you do this, you must submit it within 30 days of the date the Order was mailed. RCW 34.05.514 explains where you must file this petition and RCW 34.05.546 explains what information your Petition must include.

FINAL ORDER OF THE
GAMBLING COMMISSION

10 Licensee.

11 These matters having come before the Washington State Gambling Commission
12 (Commission) on January 11, 2018 and the Commission makes the following Findings of Fact,
13 Conclusions of Law, and issues its Final Order:

14 **I. FINDINGS OF FACT**

15 1. The Washington State Gambling Commission issued Licensee MEWE, Inc. d/b/a
16 Viking, License number: 05-19690, authorizing Punchboard/Pull-Tab activity in Lacey,
17 Washington. This license expires on June 30, 2018.

18 2. Keith Milligan is the 100% owner of MEWE, Inc. d/b/a Viking, and therefore a
19 substantial interest holder of the Licensee; both he and Licensee are subject to all state gambling
20 laws and Commission rules at all times after receiving its gambling license.

21 3. On or about August 9, 2017, Mr. Milligan's actions led to allegations that he
22 committed vehicular homicide by recklessly driving a motor vehicle on the opposite side of the
23 road while under the influence of or affected by intoxicating liquor or any drug or the
24 combination thereof, and caused the death of another person.

1 4. Mr. Milligan was charged with one count of Vehicular Homicide, a Class A
2 Felony, in Thurston County Superior Court on August 14, 2017. His criminal trial is scheduled
3 for March 26, 2018.

4 5. Director David Trujillo issued a summary suspension and administrative charges
5 on September 18, 2017 alleging that Mr. Milligan's unlawful actions as substantial interest
6 holder and sole owner of Licensee MEWE, Inc. d/b/a Viking constituted violations of RCW
7 9.46.075 and established that Licensee is a threat to the effective regulation of gambling pursuant
8 to WAC 230-03-085. Further, that Licensee could not show by clear and convincing evidence
9 that it was qualified for licensure as required by RCW 9.46.153(1), and that its substantial interest
10 holder's actions warranted revocation of its license pursuant to RCW 9.46.075(1), (8), and (9),
11 and WAC 230-03-085(1), and (8)(a).

12 6. Viking was personally served on September 19, 2017, and Licensee responded
13 with a request for hearing on September 19, 2017. Licensee was sent notice of an October 20,
14 2017 prehearing conference on September 26, 2017 to the address provided by Licensee.

15 7. Licensee failed to attend the October 20, 2017 prehearing conference, and an
16 order dismissing appeal was issued on Monday, October 23, 2017, to Licensee's last known
17 address.

18 8. To date, the Commission has received no further communication from Licensee.

20 II. CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

21 1. Licensee was served proper notice of the September 18, 2017 charges on
22 September 19, 2017 under RCW 34.05.434, RCW 34.05.431, and WAC 10-08-130.

23 2. On October 20, 2017, Licensee failed to attend or participate in a hearing or other
24 stage of an adjudicative proceeding under RCW 34.05.440(2).

1 **NOTICE**

2 Reconsideration: RCW 34.05.470 and WAC 230-17-140 provide that a party may file a
3 petition for reconsideration of a final order. A petition for reconsideration must be received no
4 later than thirteen (13) days after the date this final order is mailed. Any motion for
5 reconsideration must state the specific grounds supporting the party's request for
6 reconsideration.

7 Stay of Final Order: Filing for reconsideration does not stay the effectiveness of this
8 Order. WAC 230-17-145 provides that a party may petition the Commission for a stay of a final
9 order. Any petition for a stay should be received by the Commission within thirteen (13) days
10 after the date this final order is mailed.

11 Judicial Review: RCW 34.05.542 provides that a party may appeal this final order by
12 filing a petition for judicial review within thirty (30) days after service of this order. A petition
13 for judicial review must be filed with the appropriate superior court and served upon both the
14 Commission and the Office of the Attorney General.

15 Service: This Order was served on you three days after it was deposited in the United
16 States Postal Service regular mail, excluding the date of mailing. WAC 230-17-035.
