Enclosed is an Order of Default entered by the Commission on October 18, 2018, revoking your license/certification to conduct gambling activities. This action occurred because you did not timely respond by requesting a hearing to the administrative charges filed on August 6, 2018 against your gambling license/certification.

You have the right to move to vacate this Order. If you do so, we must receive your request by the 10th day after the Order was mailed. Your motion must include the specific grounds upon which relief is requested and must be submitted to:

You also have the right to submit a Petition for Judicial Review. If you do this, you must submit it within 30 days of the date the Order was mailed. RCW 34.05.514 explains where you must file this petition and RCW 34.05.546 explains what information your Petition must include.

10 Licensee.

11 This matter having come before the Washington State Gambling Commission
12 (Commission) on October 18, 2018, the Commission makes the following Findings of Fact,
13 Conclusions of Law, and issues its Final Order:

14 **I. FINDINGS OF FACT**

15 1. The Washington State Gambling Commission issued Licensee Sonny R.
16 Noudaranouvong License number: 68-33794, authorizing Public Card Room Employee activity
17 at Royal Casino in Everett, Washington.

18 2. This license, which expired on September 5, 2018, was issued subject to the
19 licensee's compliance with state gambling laws and Commission rules at all times after receiving
20 his gambling license.

21 3. In September, 2017, the gambling Commission opened an investigation into Mr.
22 Noudaranouvong based on an anonymous complaint.

23 4. Between December, 2017 and June, 2018, Mr. Noudaranouvong facilitated
24 illegal sports betting for patrons of Royal Casino while he worked as a dealer.

25 5. Commission Special Agents also found Mr. Noudaranouvong accepted a total of
26 twenty-one (21) wagers on sporting events from December, 2017 through June, 2018.

1 **NOTICE**

2 Reconsideration: RCW 34.05.470 and WAC 230-17-140 provide that a party may file a
3 petition for reconsideration of a final order. A petition for reconsideration must be received no
4 later than thirteen (13) days after the date this final order is mailed. Any motion for
5 reconsideration must state the specific grounds supporting the party's request for
6 reconsideration.

7 Stay of Final Order: Filing for reconsideration does not stay the effectiveness of this
8 Order. WAC 230-17-145 provides that a party may petition the Commission for a stay of a final
9 order. Any petition for a stay should be received by the Commission within thirteen (13) days
10 after the date this final order is mailed.

11 Judicial Review: RCW 34.05.542 provides that a party may appeal this final order by
12 filing a petition for judicial review within thirty (30) days after service of this order. A petition
13 for judicial review must be filed with the appropriate superior court and served upon both the
14 Commission and the Office of the Attorney General.

15 Service: This Order was served on you three days after it was deposited in the United
16 States Postal Service regular mail, excluding the date of mailing. WAC 230-17-035.


