Enclosed is an Order of Default entered by the Commission on April 12, 2018, revoking your license/certification to conduct gambling activities. This action occurred because you did not timely respond by requesting a hearing to the administrative charges filed on March 7, 2018 against your gambling license/certification.

You have the right to move to vacate this Order. If you do so, we must receive your request by the 10th day after the Order was mailed. Your motion must include the specific grounds upon which relief is requested and must be submitted to:

You also have the right to submit a Petition for Judicial Review. If you do this, you must submit it within 30 days of the date the Order was mailed. RCW 34.05.514 explains where you must file this petition and RCW 34.05.546 explains what information your Petition must include.

FINAL ORDER OF THE
GAMBLING COMMISSION

12 Class III Employee.

13 This matter having come before the Washington State Gambling Commission
14 (Commission) on April 12, 2018 and the Commission makes the following Findings of Fact,
15 Conclusions of Law, and issues its Final Order:

16 **I. FINDINGS OF FACT**

17 1. The Washington State Gambling Commission issued Remy S. Dewey a gambling
18 certification, License Number: 69-42858, authorizing Class III Employee activity at Little Creek
19 Casino in Shelton, Washington.

20 2. This certification, which expires on July 20, 2018, was issued subject to Mr.
21 Dewey's compliance with state gambling laws and Commission rules, in accordance with the
22 Squaxin-Island Tribal State Gaming Compact.

23 3. On September 12, 2017, while employed and working as a security officer at
24 Little Creek Casino, Mr. Dewey is alleged to have solicited a female patron to engage in sexual
25 conduct with him for \$60.00.

1 4. Based on the above allegation, the Squaxin Island Gaming Commission
2 suspended Mr. Dewey's tribal gaming license on September 12, 2017, and revoked the license
3 on September 21, 2017.

4 5. Mr. Dewey did not disclose the above allegations or the revocation of his tribal
5 gaming license to the Gambling Commission.

6 6. Director David Trujillo issued administrative charges on March 2, 2018 alleging
7 that Mr. Dewey's actions constituted a violation of RCW 9A.88.110, RCW 9.46.075, WAC 230-
8 06-090(1) and (5), and established that he is a threat to the effective regulation of gambling
9 pursuant to WAC 230-03-085. Further, that he could not show by clear and convincing evidence
10 that he was qualified for licensure as required by RCW 9.46.153(1), and that his actions
11 warranted revocation of his license pursuant to RCW 9.46.075(1) and (8), and WAC 230-03-
12 085(1), (7), and (8)(a), (c), and (d), and in accordance with Sections V.C.(1) and (3) of the
13 Squaxin Island Tribal-State Gaming Compact.

14 7. Mr. Dewey was sent the charges by regular and certified mail on March 7, 2018,
15 to the last address the Gambling Commission had on file. The certified mail return receipt was
16 received on March 19, 2018, indicating that delivery was completed on March 9, 2018. The
17 regular mail was not returned.

18 8. To date, the Commission has received no communication from Mr. Dewey.

19 II. CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

20 1. Mr. Remy S. Dewey was sent proper notice of the March 2, 2018 charges via
21 regular and certified mail on March 7, 2018 under RCW 34.05.434, RCW 34.05.431, and WAC
22 10-08-130.

23 2. The Commission can take final action against Mr. Dewey's gambling
24 certification under Case Number CR 2017-01566 pursuant to RCW 9.46.075, RCW
25 34.05.440(1), RCW 34.05.461, and WAC 230-03-085.

1 NOTICE

2 Reconsideration: RCW 34.05.470 and WAC 230-17-140 provide that a party may file a
3 petition for reconsideration of a final order. A petition for reconsideration must be received no
4 later than thirteen (13) days after the date this final order is mailed. Any motion for
5 reconsideration must state the specific grounds supporting the party's request for
6 reconsideration.

7 Stay of Final Order: Filing for reconsideration does not stay the effectiveness of this
8 Order. WAC 230-17-145 provides that a party may petition the Commission for a stay of a final
9 order. Any petition for a stay should be received by the Commission within thirteen (13) days
10 after the date this final order is mailed.

11 Judicial Review: RCW 34.05.542 provides that a party may appeal this final order by
12 filing a petition for judicial review within thirty (30) days after service of this order. A petition
13 for judicial review must be filed with the appropriate superior court and served upon both the
14 Commission and the Office of the Attorney General.

15 Service: This Order was served on you three days after it was deposited in the United
16 States Postal Service regular mail, excluding the date of mailing. WAC 230-17-035.
