Dear Mr. Hjorth:

Enclosed is an Order of Default entered by the Commission on July 12, 2018, revoking your license/certification to conduct gambling activities. This action occurred because you did not timely respond by requesting a hearing to the administrative charges filed on May 7, 2018 against your gambling license/certification.

You have the right to move to vacate this Order. If you do so, we must receive your request by the 10<sup>th</sup> day after the Order was mailed. Your motion must include the specific grounds upon which relief is requested and must be submitted to:

You also have the right to submit a Petition for Judicial Review. If you do this, you must submit it within 30 days of the date the Order was mailed. RCW 34.05.514 explains where you must file this petition and RCW 34.05.546 explains what information your Petition must include.

This matter having come before the Washington State Gambling Commission (Commission) on July 12, 2018 and the Commission makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and issues its Final Order:

**I. FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. The Washington State Gambling Commission issued Jordan S. Hjorth a Class III Certification, License Number: 69-42668, authorizing Class III Employee activity at ilani Casino in Ridgefield, Washington.

2. This certification, which expired on June 26, 2018, was issued subject to Mr. Hjorth's compliance with state gambling laws and Commission rules in accordance with the Cowlitz Tribal-State Gaming Compact.

3. On February 21, 2018 Mr. Hjorth was charged in Clark County Superior Court Case No. 18-1-00504-3 with one count of Possession of Stolen Property Second Degree, a Class C Felony.



**ORDER**



It is hereby **ORDERED** that Jordan S. Hjorth's gambling certification, Number 69-42668, is **REVOKED**.




